



## Attitude to Learning Descriptors

1	Students demonstrate an exemplary attitude and are <b><u>role models</u></b> for others. They are <b><u>eager to study</u></b> and <b><u>take responsibility</u></b> for their own learning. They <b><u>consistently behave</u></b> in a way which <b><u>helps themselves and others</u></b> learn.
2	Students are <b><u>proactive</u></b> in their approach to learning. They <b><u>respond quickly</u></b> to instructions and <b><u>actively participate</u></b> in lessons, which has a <b><u>positive impact</u></b> on their learning.

3	Students may need <b><u>prompts</u></b> to work and can be <b><u>slow to respond</u></b> to instructions. They do what is required but can <b><u>lack engagement</u></b> in lessons and tend only to <b><u>participate with encouragement</u></b> .
4	Students need <b><u>frequent reminders</u></b> to focus on learning and often do not respond adequately to prompts to work. They <b><u>persistently behave</u></b> in a way that <b><u>prevents the learning</u></b> of <b><u>themselves and others</u></b> .
