### Tasks

**What is the task?**

You will produce a poster or leaflet to give detailed explanations of the historical context of the novel Jekyll and Hyde.

**How is this connected to the English course?**

During Year 8, you will study extracts from the novel 'Jekyll and Hyde' by Robert Louis Stevenson.

**What format of work is expected?**

The project can be produced by computer or by hand. If you produce a poster/leaflet by hand, remember that you will need to photograph it.

**How long will this take?**

This is a week's worth of English, so you need to spend a minimum of three hours researching and then producing this work.

**What kind of information do I need to include?**

It is up to you to decide on the details of the content. However, this list is a good guide:

- Biographical details about the author
- The Victorian gentleman
- Victorian London
- Victorian ideas about psychology
- Religion and Science with a focus on Charles Darwin
